BIOGRAPH THEATER - SITE

2433 N. Lincoln Avenue, Chicago

The site where Special Agents under Melvin Purvis shot and killed a fleeing Dillinger on the night of July 22, 1934. Specifically, Dillinger was shot in the alley to the immediate SE of the theater.

LAKE COUNTY JAIL - SITE

226 S. Main Street, Crown Point, IN

This is the site of the Crown Point Jail, where Dillinger escape on March 3, 1934. Dillinger may or may not have had a carved gun that he used to aid in his escape. The hostages claim it was real, the FBI claim it was carved.

LITTLE BOHEMIA LODGE - SITE

142 US-51, Manitowish Waters, WI The site of a shootout between Dillinger and his gang, and the FBI and local law enforcement on April 22, 1934.

ST. ALEXIAN HOSPITAL - SITE

Belden Avenue & Racine Avenue, Chicago The site where of the hospital where Dillinger's body was taken after the shooting on July 22, 1934. 1
