

GANGSTER TOUR

JOE AIELLO (1890-1930) - GRAVE

Mob Boss - {Giuseppe Aiello}

Joe Aiello was a Sicilian Mob Boss, known for having a feud with Capone. He probably plotted with Bugs Moran to have his enemy, Antonio Lombardo President of the Unione Siciliana, killed. This is what probably caused the St. Valentine's Day Massacre to occur. Aiello was machine-gunned outside a friend's apartment probably by Capone.

ANTHONY "TONY" ACCARDO (1906-1992) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Tony Accardo took over the Chicago Outfit in the 40's. He was allegedly one of the shooters at the St Valentine's Day Massacre. Joe Batters, named after beating to death his enemies, never went to prison.

JOSEPH "JOEY" AIUPPA (1907-1997) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Joseph "Joey" Aiuppa was the Chicago Outfit Boss from 1971 to 1986. Went to prison for skimming in Vegas.

FELIX ALDERISIO (1912-1971) - CRYPT

Mob Boss

Felix "Milwaukee Phil" Alderisio was the Chicago Outfit Boss from 1967-1971. He was sent to prison in 1969, where he died.

SAM BATTAGLIA (1908-1973) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Sam Battaglia was Boss of the Chicago Outfit from 1966-1967. He was convicted of violating the Hobbs Act. He died at his home shortly after his release.

FRANK CALABRESE, SR. (1937-2012) - GRAVE

Mobster

Frank Calabrese Sr. ran the Chinatown crew. He was indicted in 2005 in the Family Secrets Trial, which exposed much of the Chicago Outfit and resulted in many convictions. He died in prison.

ALPHONSE "AL" CAPONE (1899-1947) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Al Capone was called to Chicago by Johnny Torrio, who came to Chicago because he was called in by Big Jim Colosimo. Capone soon rose to control almost the entire city of Chicago. Capone is synonymous with organized crime and gangsters.

Mobster

Al Capone's Older Brother

Al Capone's older brother Ralph operated a bottling plant. He was cremated, but he has a cenotaph with his brother.

Mob Boss

Sam Carlisi was the Boss of the Chicago Outfit from 1986-1996. He was convicted and sentenced on racketeering charges and died in prison.

Mob Underboss

Jackie Cerone was the Chicago Outfit's Underboss from 1967-1986.

JAMES "BIG JIM" COLOSIMO (1878-1920) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Big Jim Colosimo built a criminal empire based upon prostitution, gambling and racketeering. He also created the first Chicago Crime organization. He was killed by Torrio because he opposed selling alcohol during prohibition.

SAM "MAD SAM" DESTEFANO (1909-1973) - GRAVE

Mobster

Sam DeStefano was a mobster who had a reputation of being extremely violent, ruthless and cruel. He was also reportedly a psychopathy. He eventually got too crazy, drawing unwanted attention to himself and the Outfit, and was gunned down by Tony Spilotro.

JOHN DIFRONZO (1928-2018) - CRYPT

Mob Street Boss

John DiFronzo was the street Boss of the Chicago Outfit from 1989-1993. He died from complications due to dementia at his house.

VINCENT DRUCCI (1898-1927) - GRAVE

Mobster

Vincent Drucci was a close associate of Dean O'Banion, until his murder by Torrio. Then the North Side Gang was headed by Hymie Weiss, Bugs Moran and Drucci. Drucci was killed by Chicago Police while in custody.

JOSEPH "DIAMOND JOE" ESPOSITO (1871-1928) - GRAVE

Politician - {Giuseppe Esposito}

Joe Esposito was Chicago's 19th Ward Alderman who protected both Torrio and the Genna's. He was killed on the front steps of home by probably a Capone shooter.

JOSEPH FERRIOLA (1927-1989) - GRAVE

Mob Street Boss

Joseph Ferriola was the street Boss of the Chicago Outfit 1986-1989. He died of heart problems.

ANGELO "BLOODY ANGELO" GENNA (1898-1925) - TOMB

Mob Enforcer

Angelo Genna was part of the Terrible Genna family, and was the enforcer of a Sicilian Gang, who allied with Capone and was enemies with the North Side Gang. He was shot to death by Bugs Moran.

MIKE "MIKE THE DEVIL" GENNA (1895-1925) - TOMB

Mob Boss

Mike Genna was part of the Terrible Genna family, and was a mobster in a Sicilian Gang, who allied with Capone and was enemies with the North Side Gang. He was shot by police after a shootout with the North Side Gang, and he bled out in the ambulance on the way to the hospital.

Mobster

SAM "SALVATORE" GENNA (1884-1951) - TOMB

Mobster

Peter Genna was part of the Terrible Genna family, and was a mobster in a Sicilian Gang, who allied with Capone and was enemies with the North Side Gang. He, along with 2 other brothers, fled to Sicily after his brothers Mike, Angelo and Tony were murdered.

TONY "THE GENTLEMAN" GENNA (1890-1925) - TOMB

Mobster

Tony "The Gentleman" Genna was part of the Terrible Genna family, and was a mobster in a Sicilian Gang, who allied with Capone and was enemies with the North Side Gang. He was asked by a friend to meet him, at which time he was ambushed and shot to death by the North Side Gang.

VINCENZO "JIM" GENNA (1888-1931) - TOMB

Mob Boss

Vincenzo "Jim" Genna was part of the Terrible Genna family, and headed this Sicilian Gang, who allied with Capone and was enemies with the North Side Gang. He, along with 2 other brothers, fled to Sicily after his brothers Mike, Angelo and Tony were murdered.

SAM GIANCANA (1908-1975) – GRAVE

Mob Boss

Sam Giancana was Boss of the Chicago Outfit from 1957-1966. Giancana was a showy Mob Boss, who liked the attention of the press. He was shot to death in his house in 1975, by an unknown person.

JOSEPH "HOP TOAD" GIUNTA (1887-1929) – GRAVE

Mobster

High ranking South Side Gang member. He planned a take over of Al Capone's gang, which was found out about. Al Capone beat Giunta to death with a bat in retaliation.

FRANK GUSENBERG (1893-1929) – GRAVE

Mob Hitmen

Frank Gusenberg was a principal hitman for the North Side Gang. he was also one of the victims of the St. Valentine's Day Massacre. He survived the initial shooting and was taken to the hospital where he eventually died. He was originally buried in Rosehill Cemetery, but were later moved to Irving Park Cemetery.

PETER GUSENBERG (1888-1929) - GRAVE

Mob Hitman

Peter Gusenberg was a principal hitman for the North Side Gang. he was also one of the victims of the St. Valentines's Day Massacre. He was originally buried in Rosehill Cemetery, but were later moved to Irving Park Cemetery.

JAKE GUSIK (1886-1956) - GRAVE

Mob Money Man

Jake Guzik was the financial genius behind the Chicago Outfit from Capone until the 1950's.

ALBERT KACHELLEK (1887-1929) - GRAVE

Mob Under Boss

Albert Kachellek, AKA James Clark, was the North Side Gangs under boss. He was also one of the victims of the St. Valentine's Day Massacre.

JAKE LINGLE (1891-1930) - GRAVE

Journalist

Jake Lingle was a journalist with the Chicago Tribune. He was what was known a a legman, one who uncovered the information and phoned it in. He was murdered in broad daylight one day in downtown Chicago. It became known afterwards, that Lingle was also involved in mob activities.

ANTONIO LOMBARDO (1891-1928) - GRAVE

President Unione Siciliana

Antonio Lombardo was Capone's advisor after Torrio retired. He also got elected President of Unione Siciliana, which the North Side Gang opposed, due to ties to Capone. He was gunned down at Dearborn and Madison, in downtown Chicago, probably by the North Side Gang. Supposedly, his execution caused the St. Valentine's Day Massacre.

JOHN MAY (1894-1929) - GRAVE

Mobster

A member of the North Side Gang. May was one of the victims of the St. Valentine's Day Massacre.

JACK MCGURN (1902-1936) - GRAVE

Mob Hitman - {Vincenzo Antonio Gibaldi}

Jack "Machine Gun Jack" McGurn was the South Side Gangs hitman. His weapon of choice was the Thompson Sub-machine gun, or Tommy gun. He was reputed to have plan the St, Valentine's Day Massacre, but was probably not present. He was killed by 3 unknown gunmen at the Avenue Recreation Bowling Alley in Chicago.

MICHELE "MIKE" MERLO (1880-1924) - GRAVE

Political Fixer

Mike was a political fixer who managed to keep the North Side Gang (O'Bannon), the South Side Gang (Torrio & Capone) and the Sicilian Gangs (Gennas) at peace. Two days after he died of cancer in 1924, open warfare broke out.

LESTER 'BABY FACE' NELSON (1908-1934) – GRAVE

Mobster - {Lester Joseph Gillis}

Lester Nelson was a gangster who joined up with Dillinger, robbing banks. In 1934 Nelson was involved in a shootout with two FBI agents near Barrington, IL. The FBI agents were killed but so was Nelson, ending his career.

FRANK NITTI (1886-1943) - GRAVE

Mob Boss - {Frank Nitto}

The successor to Capone. Nitti committed suicide when he was ordered Ricca to go to prison for extorting Hollywood. Because Nitti was claustrophobic, he would not have been able to handle prison.

DEAN "DION" O'BANION (1892-1924) - GRAVE

Mob Boss - {Charles Dean O'Banion}

Dean O'Banion was the North Side Boss until his death probably at the hands of Johnny Torrio and Al Capone.

PAUL RICCA (1886-1943) - GRAVE

Mob Boss

Paul Ricca was the de facto leader of the Chicago Outfit for 40 years.

FRANK RIO (1895-1935) - GRAVE

Mobster

Frank Rio was Al Capone's Personal Bodyguard. He may have been the one to uncover Giunta's plot to assassinate Capone. He had a reputation of being able to stay out of jail. He died of natural causes.

TONY SPILOTRO (1938-1986) - GRAVE

Mobster

Tony "The Ant" Spilotro was a mobster who was unusually violent. He was Chicago's man in Vegas for years, creating his own criminal empire in Nevada. Over time, his antics upset the Chicago Outfit's upper echelon enough that he and his brother were both murdered.

ROGER TOUHY (1898-1959) – GRAVE

Mobster

Roger Touhy was a bootlegger who originally sold alcohol to Capone. Over time, friction developed between the two. Touhy was framed for murder in 1933 and spent 25 years behind bars. He was gunned down less than a month later.

EARL "HYMIE" WEISS (1898-1926) - GRAVE

Mob Boss - {Henryk Wojciechowski}

After the death of Dion O'Banion, Weiss, Bugs Moran and Vincent Drucci ran the North Side Gang. Hymie was gunned down in front of Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago by the South Side Gang, probably Machine Gun Jack being one of the shooters.
